About the Service

Microsoft Teams is part of the Microsoft 365 platform and is used by schools as a workplace communication and collaboration, as well creating collaborative online classrooms and learning spaces for teachers and pupils.

This Microsoft Office 365 Teams Setup Service is designed to support schools configure their Microsoft Teams for workplace communication. It will help streamline collaboration between school leaders, administrators, teachers, and provide shared cloud-based file storage. It helps ensure that important information is structured efficiently and helps keep staff informed.

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Additional information



Is anything required before I can use this service?

You will need:

 A Microsoft 365 tenancy supported by Education Digital Services (this is part of your Broadband and Online Services subscription).

NOTE: If your school has taken the Microsoft 365 Devolved Admin option, you will need to ensure a member of staff with Global Administration privileges is available throughout the consultancy.

We strongly also recommend the following:

- Staff must have unique identities set up and we strongly recommend all staff have multifactor authentication (MFA) enabled on their account. To find out more about MFA additional information Visit our Security and Online Safety pages on our website and see
- Ensure your school has a suitable system to backup data stored in OneDrive and Teams.
 You can purchase a <u>Microsoft 365 backup service</u> through Education Digital Services.

Important: We recommend that once MFA has been enabled on accounts that your school also requests "Conditional Access" to be set up. This will reduce the number of times staff are challenged to enter additional codes (MFA) when they login. To do this, you will require either Microsoft A3 or A5 subscription licencing, as each staff member will need an A3 Faculty licence assigned. These A3 or A5 EES Licences can be purchased through Education Digital Services via our Microsoft EES Subscription Agreement.

How many consultancy hours will be needed for this service?

This consultancy can vary in length, depending on the level of advice needed by your school but this will be discussed with you as part of the initial consultation.

We would anticipate that two consultancy sessions will be required of between 1 to 3 hours depending on the size of your school and the number of staff being setup.

Are there other ways our school can setup MFA?

We also offer downloadable User Guides for schools that subscribe to our Broadband and Online Services or our SIMS support (available in the support section of our website).

Alternatively, schools subscribing to our Technical Support for Curriculum Networks can ask their technician to help or log a request with our ICT Service Centre.
